4. Chardonnay Sur Lie 'Bon Vallon' De Wetshof, Robertson, South Africa This Chardonnay is a fresh and expressive, unwooded version. The nose is delicate with aromas of lemon, honeysuckle blossom and peach.	6.2	8.7	25.5
5. Sauvignon Blanc, Wairau River Family, Marlborough, New Zealand Clean and crisp it is bursting with a flinty minerality with flavours of grapefruit, gooseberry, herbs and white stone fruit. Expressive on the palate, finishing with great length.	6.3	8.8	26
6. Vinho Verde 'Azal' AB Valley Wines, Amarante, Portugal The palate is very fresh with a zingy acidity and notes of green apple, white peach, grapefruit and a hint of elderflower.	6.5	9.25	27
7. Soave Classico, Balestri Valda (organic), Italy This aromatic white has an abundance of stone fruits and blossom on the nose.			28
8. Pinot Gris 'Roaring Meg' Mt Difficulty, Central Otago, New Zealand Full of tropical and stone fruit flavours such as melon, mango, peach and passionfruit. A lovely textured mouthfeel on the palate with a lingering finish.			31.5
9. Albarino, Genio y Figura, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain A fresh Albarino with ripe stone fruit flavours and a crisp, citrus acidity.			32.5
10. Barrel Fermented Rioja Blanco, Finca Nueva, Rioja Alta, Spain Light gold in colour with honey and peaches on the nose.			35
11. Chateau Peybonhomme Les Tours Blanc, Cotes du Blaye, Bordeaux (biodynamic), France The wine has a fresh, citrus acidity which balances perfectly the tropical fruits and subtle creamy notes from one third of the wine being aged in French oak barrels.			39
12. Pouilly Fume 'Les Berthiers' Domaine Landrat et Guyollot, Loire Valley, France This dry white has layers of clean Sauvignon Blanc fruit combined with added complexity due to the minerality derived from these soils.			40
13. Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Fourneaux' Domaine Alain Gautheron, France Fresh, floral aromas of apple blossom combined with a creamy texture and a distinct mineral complexity.			49
14. Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Jean Pascal, Burgundy, France Lightly oak retaining butterscotch and hazelnuts hints, finishes with complex flavours of brioche and cinnamon.			85

15. Pinot Grigio Ramato Rose, Il Barco, Veneto, Italy Delicate perfumed aromas of peach and rose petals and soft, red fruit flavours on the palate, dry and well balanced.			20
16. Rose de Languedoc, Bastion de la Cite, Lorgueil, IGP Carcassonne, France This delicate rose from Carcassonne is crisp and clean with raspberries, redcurrants and white blossom, well balanced with a fresh citrus acidity and a fruit forward finish.	5.9	8	24
17. Chateau Paradis, Coteaux d'AIX en Provence, France A well balanced wine with red fruit flavours and a fresh acidity. Round in the mouth with a long and fruity finish.			31

22.	Reserve Merlot, 'Block 10' La Playa, Colchagua Valley, Chile Garnet red in colour with complex aromas on the nose of vanilla bean and toasted oak, sparked by ripe black plums and sweet cherry jam.	6.2	8.7	25
23.	Pinot Noir, Long Barn, California, USA Well structured with soft tannins and a silky mouthfeel, the fresh fruit flavours linger on the palate.	6.3	8.8	26
24.	Chateau Le Gardera, Bordeaux Superieur, France Le Gardera has fine tannins, soft fruit with subtle oak and an excellent balance.			27
25.	Malbec, 'Alpataco' Familia Schroeder, Patagonia, Argentina Smooth mouth feel, this is a fresh and fruit wine that carries vanilla and caramel notes from ageing in small oak barrels.	6.4	9	27
26.	Beaujolais Villages 'Vignes de 1940' Domaine Jean Michel Dupre, France Dark ruby in colour with notes of sweet blackcurrants on the nose. The palate has fresh black cherry and berries with a mineral character on the finish.			30
27.	Rioja Crianza, 'Torno' Hacienda El Ternero, Rioja Alta, Spain The nose is perfumed with violets and cherries. The palate is fresh and structured with notes of black fruits with spices and hints of caramel from the oak influence on the finish.	7.5	10.7	31
28.	Syrah 'Back Block' Brookfields Estate, Hawkes Bay, New Zealand A dark ruby colour with sweet berry fruits on the nose. The palate is round and approachable with notes of blackberries, cloves, pepper and earthy tannins.			35
29.	Valpolicella Ripasso Classico Superiore, Gorgo di Bricolo, Veneto (organic), Italy A well-structured wine with notes of black cherries, chocolate, vanilla, pepper and raisined fruits. Velvety smooth with a long finish.			39
30.	Chateau Louvie, St Emilion Grand Cru, France The blend of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon creates a wine with a soft, smooth palate and plenty of berry and plum fruits, combined with a woodland scent and a long savoury finish.			45
31.	Rully 'Les Chauchoux' Domaine Belleville, Burgundy, France A mineral rich Pinot with ripe summer pudding aromas, a hint of oak adding complexity and softness to the exuberant flavour of cherries, refined, elegant with a pure yet intense redcurrant fruit.			50
32.	Beaune 1er Cru 'Clos du Roy' Domaine Prieur Brunet, Burgundy, France This classic Beaune has soft, accessible Pinot fruit with a seductive perfumed bouquet and hints of cherry and raspberry on the palate.			80
33.	Brunello di Montalcino, Donatella Colombini, Tuscany, Italy Powerful and assertive in character, complex with mineral, leather, truffle and orange peel nuances, robust and full-bodied on the palate.			85
