8. Pinot Gris 'Roaring Meg' Mt Difficulty, Central Otago, New Zealand A lovely textured mouthfeel on the palate with a lingering finish. Full of tropical and stone fruit flavours such as melon, mango, peach and passionfruit.			33
9. Albarino, Genio y Figura, Rias Baixas, Galicia, Spain A fresh Albarino with ripe stone fruit flavours and a crisp, citrus acidity.			34.5
10. Pecorino 'Civitas' Cantine Orsogna, Terre di Chieti (Biodynamic), Italy A soft and pleasant wine with aromas of citrus, ripe pear, peach and orange blossom.			37
11. Chateau Peybonhomme Les Tours Blanc, Cotes du Blaye, Bordeaux (Biodynamic), France The wine has a fresh, citrus acidity which balances perfectly the tropical fruits and subtle creamy notes from one third of the wine being aged in French oak barrels.			42
12. Bacchus, Forty Hall Vineyard, Enfield London (Organic), UK Fresh with a punchy bouquet of blossom, green apples and gooseberry. The palate is light and dry with notes of grapefruit, honeysuckle and a crisp, zesty acidity.			45.5
13. Chablis, Domaine Garnier et Fils, France Pale yellow in colour with a subtle nose of white flowers, apple and cut grass. The floral flavours follow through on the palate with notes of lemon, apple, white peach and distinctive chalky flintiness.			53
14. Puligny Montrachet, Domaine Jean Pascal, Burgundy, France Lightly oak retaining butterscotch and hazelnuts hints, finishes with complex flavours of brioche and cinnamon.			88

15. Pinot Grigio Ramato Rose, Il Barco, Veneto, Italy Delicate perfumed aromas of peach and rose petals and soft, red fruit flavours on the palate, dry and well balanced.			21.5

21. Carignan ' Vieilles Vignes 'Roche de Belanne, IGP d'Oc, France A ripe and concentrated wine, deep ruby in colour with an alluring nose of sweet ripe strawberry and dark cherry, it is supple with ripe fruit flavours and very light tannins.			25
22. Reserve Merlot, 'Block 10' La Playa, Colchagua Valley, Chile Garnet red in colour with complex aromas on the nose of vanilla bean and toasted oak, sparked by ripe black plums and sweet cherry jam.	6.4	9	26.5

29. Valpolicella Ripasso Classico Superiore, Gorgo di Bricolo, Veneto (Organic), Italy A well-structured wine with notes of black cherries, chocolate, vanilla, pepper and raisined fruits. Velvety smooth with a long finish.			42
30. Chateau Louvie, St Emilion Grand Cru, France The blend of 80% Merlot and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon creates a wine with a soft, smooth palate and plenty of berry and plum fruits, combined with a woodland scent and a long savoury finish.			47.5
31. Rully 'Les Chauchoux' Domaine Belleville, Burgundy, France A mineral rich Pinot with ripe summer pudding aromas, a hint of oak adding complexity and softness to the exuberant flavour of cherries, refined, elegant with a pure yet intense redcurrant fruit.			53
32. Chateau Batailley, 5eme Cru Classe Pauillac, France Deep in colour, Chateau Batailley has lovely fruit concentration of blackcurrant, red cherry and a pleasant graphite scent. The palate is medium-bodied with ripe, grippy tannins. There is a core of sweet fruit with a smooth, very fine and long harmonious finish.			89
33. Brunello di Montalcino, Donatella Colombini, Tuscany, Italy Powerful and assertive in character, complex with mineral, leather, truffle and orange peel nuances, robust and full-bodied on the palate.			89

37. Champagne AR Lenoble Brut Rose, France Delicate salmon pink in colour, with fine bubbles, a light sparkling foam and a fruity nose, with scents of red fruits.			80
38. Champagne Bollinger Special Cuvee, France Full flavoured, biscuity and very well balanced with an elegant and refined finish and superb length on the palate.			98
39. Champagne Dom Perignon, France On the mouth the wine has remarkable persistence with slight tones of citrus zest.			230
